Parking

- Number of accessible spaces
- Sign requirements
- Slopes
- Space & access aisle size
- Marking of access aisles







Accessible Exterior Routes

- Where required
- Missing routes
- Walkway slopes
- Changes in floor level
- Ramps & curb ramps







Building Entrances

- Required number
- Door landings & maneuvering space
- Door thresholds
- Hardware
- Closing speed & opening pressure







Restrooms

- Signs
- Room size
- Fixtures
- Grab bars
- Mirrors & Dispensers







Accessible Interior Routes

- Aisle widths
- Corridor widths
- Obstacles & hazards







Access Heights

- Counters
- Bars
- Tables

- Required locations
- Fixed vs. portable
- Common installation problems
