

- I in 6 Americans develop foodborne illness every year (about 48 million people)
- 128,000 hospitalizations per year
- 3,000+ deaths per year
- Two distinct causal groups
  - 31 known pathogens (20% of illnesses)\*
  - Unspecified agents (80% of illnesses)\*






## Top 5 Pathogens contributing to domestically acquired foodborne illness-2016\*


