# Minimum Wage Increases

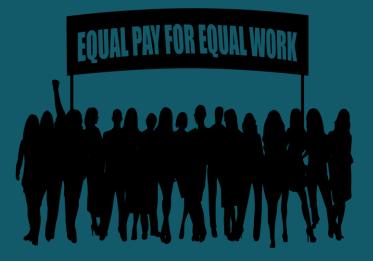
- State Minimum Wage:
  - Arizona:
    - \$10.50 (Jan. 1, 2018)
    - \$11.00 (Jan. 1, 2019)
    - \$12.00 (Jan. 1, 2020)
  - California (26 or more EEs):
    - \$11.00 (Jan. 1, 2018)
    - \$12.00 (Jan. 1, 2019)
    - \$13.00 (Jan. 1, 2020)

- Oregon:
  - \$10.75 (Jan. 1, 2018)
  - \$11.25 (Jan. 1, 2019)
  - \$12.00 (Jan. 1, 2020)
- Washington:
  - \$11.50 (Jan. 1, 2018)
  - \$12.00 (Jan. 1, 2019)
  - \$13.50 (Jan. 1, 2020)



# **California AB 168 – No Salary History Inquiries**

- Part of growing nationwide trend (Delaware, Oregon, Massachusetts, SF, NYC, Philadelphia).
- Proponents argue that salary history inquiries perpetuate wage inequality when employers base a new hire's compensation on prior rate of pay.

- Accrual vs. Front Load
  - The accrual method is generally more cost effective because it requires employees to work in order to earn sick leave
  - The front load method is administratively less burdensome
