Human Response During Fire Events: Evidence from Behavioral Research

Observed Evacuation Behavior

- Most frequent behaviors
 - Notifying others
 - . Searching for fire
 - . Evacuating
- . Time delay in evacuation

Mental Processes Underlying Evacuation Behavior

- Reason for evacuation delay
 - Social inhibition
 - Increase in mental workload
 - Misjudgment
 - Anxiety reducing behaviors
