Compliance Considerations

- Whether the beverages must be in original manufacturer containers only or whether mixed drinks by the retailer are allowed and in what vessel;
- Whether third party companies may deliver or whether delivery must be by retailer employees;
- Age of delivery driver;
- Total volume of alcohol per order;
- Hours of sale and delivery/pickup;
- Recordkeeping and age verification; and
- Food-related requirements.
