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INDICATORS OF DRUG USAGE BY EMPLOYEES



Routinely arrives late or leaves early
Late or absent after lunch often
Frequent or long disappearances from the work site
Frequent or long trips to the bathroom or to the stockroom
Misses appointments
Frequent sick days or unexplained absences
Procrastination, pattern of missed deadlines
Neglects mail
Phone calls are not returned promptly
Decline in productivity or hours worked
Doesn't pay attention and forgets things easily
Overreacts to criticism, blames others
Evidence of depression and/or anxiety
Unusual mood swings–unpredictability
Unable to get along with colleagues, staff
Performance declines over the course of the day

INDICATORS OF DRUG USAGE BY EMPLOYEES



Client complaints about performance, accessibility, communication
Co-mingles or borrows clients' funds
Seems to make and receive a lot of personal calls
Appears under the influence or smells of alcohol in the office
Gradual deterioration in appearance, hygiene, health
Always tired
Loses control at social gatherings where professional decorum is expected
Dishonesty, manipulations
